This year we are offering two scholarships and will be choosing a winner for each prompt. **Applicants are welcome to apply for both scholarships**, however can only win for one prompt. Application Requirements

- Must be a PA student currently enrolled and in good standing in an ARC-PA-accredited PA program in the state of Florida and a student member of FSDPA
- Completed scholarship application signed by PA Program Director

Scholarship #1

- Submit an original (no AI) essay submission of 500 words or less in 12 point Times New Roman font addressing one of the following topics:
 - 1. Promoting Skin Cancer Awareness and Prevention in Florida's Outdoor Work Force
 - 2. Addressing Dermatologic Disparities in Florida's Underserved Communities
 - 3. Describe the impact that you believe social media has on spread of dermatologic information, awareness of dermatology conditions, and how this has impacted care.

Scholarship #2

- Submit an original (no AI) essay submission of 500 words or less in 12 point Times New Roman font highlighting a charitable organization focused on impacting or educating about a dermatologic topic you think deserves a special highlight and financial support. The winner's organization of choice will receive a \$10,000 donation from the FSDPA.
